

Domestic White Wines

2012 Cakebread Chardonnay, *Napa Valley* **70.00**

The Cakebread family has made quite a name for themselves with their full-bodied Chardonnays, and has been highly sought after over the years. A crisp, flinty style. With peach, pear, anise and nectarine notes and little if any noticeable oak.

2012 Hanna Chardonnay, *Russian River Valley* **43.00**

A creamy hazelnut flavor with buttery, tropical characters gives this wine its rich and smooth finish.

2012 Hess Select Chardonnay, *Napa Valley* **26.00**

A delicious, intensely fruity, medium-bodied wine that is a pleasure to drink.

2011 Jordan Chardonnay, *Russian River Valley* **60.00**

Aromas of freshly cut Fuji and Granny Smith apples, stone fruits and white flowers lead to vibrant minerality and bright fruit flavors. The creamy mid-palate is framed by well-integrated French oak and lively acidity that carry through to a refreshingly long finish

2013 Kendall-Jackson Chardonnay, *Napa Valley* **30.00**

Buttery and rich with fruit, and a nice touch of oak. America's favorite Chardonnay!

2011 Mer Soleil Chardonnay, *Central Coast, California* **49.00**

Full bodied and lush in texture, amber gold in color and fully ripe with aromas and flavors reminiscent of tropical fruit.

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2012 Rombauer Chardonnay, *Napa Valley* **55.00**

A rich Chardonnay with layers of tropical fruit, peaches, and pears. The fruit opens into creamy texture of apples and pears that glide across the palate. Hints of citrus and light oak tones highlights the wines lingering finish.

2012 Sonoma-Cutrer “Russian River Ranches” Chardonnay, *Sonoma* **39.00**

Intense and lively, rich and concentrated, with pear, hazelnut and light vanilla shadings. Well focused with a long rich finish.

2012 Cakebread Sauvignon Blanc, *Napa Valley* **48.00**

Intense melon and citrus fruit aromas with delicate floral and herbal notes. Long, silky finish and blended with Semillon grape for perfect balance.

2013 Kenwood Sauvignon Blanc, *Napa Valley* **27.00**

For many years Kenwood has been recognized as one of California’s top Sauvignon Blanc producers. It is the wineries most popular wines. Clean and crisp with melon and fruit flavors on the finish.

2012 King Estate Pinot Gris, *Oregon* **38.00**

A deliciously versatile wine, full-bodied with aromas and flavors of peach, apple, citrus and pear. Excellent balance all the way through the long, spicy finish.

2012 Caymus Conundrum, *California* **40.00**

This wine embodies the pioneering aspects of California’s wine industry. A wine that escapes definition, yet pleases the palate with lush and spicy characteristics. A blend of Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc, Semillon, Viognier, and Muscat are blended to produce this wine of floral and tropical flavors.

2012 Chateau St. Michelle Riesling, *Washington State* **25.00**

Delivers sweet lime and peach characters with subtle mineral notes

Domestic Red Wines

N/V10Cain Cuvee, *Napa Valley* **55.00**

A delicious Cabernet blend with fresh blackberry, pepper and vanilla aromas, with flavors of cherry, chocolate and cedar.

2009 Cain Five, *Napa Valley* **160.00**

A classic wine that has a blend of five varietals, Cabernet, Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Malbec, and Petite Verdot. This wine displays depth, richness and nuances of each of these varietals used to create Cain Five.

2009 Dry Creek Vineyards Meritage, *Dry Creek Valley, Sonoma* **48.00**

This full bodied, Bordeaux style blend is well structured with flavors of lush, dark, fruits and a hint spice. Immediate scents of blackberry and cherry jump out of the glass followed by more subtle aromas of cloves and cinnamon. This is a richly textured cabernet with a long finish.

2011 Estancia Red Meritage, *Paso Robles* **48.00**

A sophisticated, rich, complex and luscious wine. A thick, deep and explosive Wine with chocolate dipped black fruit flavors, envelope in rich sweet oak, Firm and structured with ripe tannins and a long, fruit driven finish.

2011 Franciscan Magnificent, *Napa Valley* **70.00**

Elegant enticing aromas of dark cherry and plum with a dark chocolate background and notes of cocoa and spice. Appealing and complex.

2010 Arizona Stronghold Mandala Red, *Napa Valley, Paso Robles* **30.00**

On the nose, voluptuous aromas of dark cherry, blackberry, and spice emanate from the glass. Red plums and pomegranate join the dark fruits with flawless synergy. Then more layers are revealed: Tingly black pepper, anise, vanilla and violets. All that fruitiness and perfume is balanced with good acidity, supple tannins and bit of earth

2011 Souverain Cabernet Sauvignon, *North Coast* **32.00**

A classic North Coast wine with rich black cherry flavors of Alexander Valley, Blackberry aromatics of Napa with rich tannins and Dutch chocolate notes from the volcanic Hills of Lake County

2009 Beringer Private Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon, *Napa Valley* **175.00**

Exhibits a dense red purple, as well as an extraordinary nose of blackberries, white Chocolate, licorice, tobacco leaf, charcoal, and a burning ember note reminiscent of a Graves from Bordeaux. A dense, luscious, full bodied, opulent style with sweet tannins. This locked and loaded, intense, full throttled Reserve Cab is ready to enjoy.

2012 BonAnno Cabernet Sauvignon, *Napa Valley* **37.00**

A deep ruby red, this seductive Cab shows classic Cabernet Sauvignon aromas of spice and sage followed by a mix of blueberries and blackberries with fresh raspberry notes. With a nice balance of acid and well integrated tannins.

2012 Buehler Cabernet Sauvignon, *Napa Valley* **40.00**

One of the Napa Valley's classis cabernets! Medium-full bodied with dried plum red cherry and berryish notes the carry onto a full-flavored finish.

2010 Cakebread Cabernet Sauvignon, *Napa Valley* **125.00**

This is classic Cakebread Cellars Cabernet Sauvignon. The 2009 vintage boasts enticing ripe blackberry, black cherry and blueberry fruit aromas, accented by subtle scents of chocolate, earth and leather.

2011 Caymus Cabernet Sauvignon, *Napa Valley* **125.00**

Powerful aromas of ripe blackberry and dark cherry, with notes of vanilla, cocoa and rose petal. In the mouth, the wine exudes richness and a finely-grained

2012 Educated Guess, *Napa Valley* **35.00**

Wow, what a Cabernet... its rich ripe and focused with juicy blackberry and cherry fruit, cocoa and hints of mint all tied together with a creamy French vanilla middle and a lingering finish. 90% Cabernet Sauvignon, 6% Merlot, 3% Cab Franc, 1% Petite Verdot.

2010 Clos du Val, Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley **40.00**

Deep garnet-black in color with aromas of black fruit. Complex spices, and hints of toast.

2011 Darioush Cabernet Sauvignon, *Napa Valley* **140.00**

Finely knit tannins support a rich, full-bodied mid-palate of crème de cassis, European dark chocolate, espresso, and exotic all-spice

2010 Faust Cabernet Sauvignon, *Napa Valley* **85.00**

The wine opens with aromas of red and black cherries, ripe raspberry, hints of violets and a lovely perfume. A lush, full entry on the palate with blackberry cassis, coffee and dark chocolates leads to a rich supple mouth feel.

2011 Folie a Deux Cabernet Sauvignon **38.00**

Chocolate mingles with layers of blackberry and black cherry on the palate while the well integrated tannins provide a nice finish.

2012 Franciscan Cabernet Sauvignon, *Napa Valley* **45.00**

Aromas of rich chocolate, coffee, cassis, mixed dark fruit. Super rich and mouth-filling flavors of cassis, coffee, and toasted oak that lends to a great body and texture with, ripe, supple tannins on the lingering finish.

2010 Groth Cabernet Sauvignon, *Napa Valley* **90.00**

With full, rich aromas and flavors redolent of ripe stone fruit and dark berries, this cabernet is a lush wine with a subtle tannin backbone.

- Aromas of red and black fruit of currants, cherry and blackberry layered with spicy notes of anise, vanilla and with a subtle cedar character of American oak.
- 2011 Mount Veeder Cabernet Sauvignon, *Napa Valley*** **64.00**
- Sharply focused, with rich, complex core of black cherry, plum, wild berry and spice that unfold to reveal depth and complexity, this wine offers a sense of elegance and finesse. Received 91 points from Wine Enthusiast

- A blend of Merlot, Syrah, Cabernet Franc, and Malbec are all added to this Cabernet Sauvignon which results in a lush berry flavored wine. This wine is rich and deep, with exceptional balance and mature, velvety tannins to the finish.
- 2010 Pine Ridge Cabernet Sauvignon, *Napa Valley*** **115.00**
- Complex, and well balanced, with dark berry, plum and currant flavors. Shows touches of toasty oak and spice.
- 2011 Rombauer Cabernet Sauvignon, *Napa Valley*** **70.00**
- This delicious wine has rich, ripe flavors of blackberry, currant, plum and wild berry that linger on the finish. Complex and nicely balanced with firm tannins.
- 2009 Silver Oak Cabernet Sauvignon, *Alexander Valley*** **115.00**
- Reveals a saturated ruby/purple color in addition to a lusty, sweet perfume of cassis, spice box, licorice and lavender. This wine is ripe and medium to full bodied with low acidity, abundant glycerin, wood, and alcohol with admirable texture as well as length.

Domestic Red Wines

2009 Silver Oak Cabernet Sauvignon, *Napa Valley* **155.00**

Silver Oak is a classic Cabernet Sauvignon with a dark, ruby red color and exquisite nose of cassis, violets, roasting coffee, chocolate, vanilla and clove. It has a rich, balanced mouth-feel dripping with ripe berries and chocolate. Medium tannins are well integrated into the long finish.

2010 Simi “Landslide” Cabernet Sauvignon, *Alexander Valley* **60.00**

Blackberry and plum flavors are accented with cocoa and spice, giving layers of complexity and depth. Full on the palate, ripe tannins yield lasting flavors and intensity.

2011 Clos Du Bois Merlot, *Sonoma* **34.00**

A consistently good producer of Merlot, soft and supple with rich plum flavors and a nice French oak finish.

2011 Franciscan Merlot, *Napa Valley* **40.00**

Supple and ripe plum, blackberry and chocolate concentrated flavors and a long, round finish. An intense wine, that show nuances of black plum, blackcherry, spice, mocha, caramel and blackberry with hints of black pepper.

2009 Sebastini “Cask” Merlot, *Sonoma* **35.00**

Light, fruity and spicy with soft berry and oak flavors.

2012 Klinker Brick Farrah Syrah, *Lodi, California* **36.00**

Aromas of dark fruit, tobacco, leather and pepper. On the palate, there are layers of plum, chocolate, and exotic spices. This wine is mouth filling with bright fruit and exceptional balance

2012 McManis Petite Syrah, *California* **26.00**

Dark purple in color, with a bright hue, this wine has a dense, jammy Boysenberry aroma, which is accompanied by a creamy vanilla and slightly smoky character. The wine is soft and round on the palate and is full of berry.

Domestic Red Wines

2011 Michael David “Petit Petit” Syrah, *Lodi* **36.00**

Aged 16 months in new French oak, this carnivalistic blend of Petit Sirah and Petit Verdot is definitely the star of the show. Trunk-fulls of blueberry, plum, violet and chalky tannins give a seamless finish to this jumbo-sized offering.

2010 Artesa Pinot Noir, *Carneros* **42.00**

Featuring flavors of strawberry, cherry, and allspice, this Pinot Noir is Accentuated with hints of caramel and toasty oak. Smooth and silky, This wine is expressive and finely balanced

2011 Byron Pinot Noir **45.00**

Rich aromas of ripe cherry, red plum, tobacco, cedar and clove are highlighted by pleasing accents of rose petals. The wine displays remarkable intensity in flavor, featuring hints of black cherry, plum spice and a nicely integrated oak component.

2012 Chalone Pinot Noir, *Monterey* **35.00**

Silky, with a pretty array of black cherry, plum and raspberry-scented fruit that is deftly balanced, complex and elegantly styled, turning delicate and perfume

2011 Hangtime Pinot Noir, *California* **32.00**

Lovely delicate, intriguing fruit character, vivid red fruit with hints of spice, a lithe texture, and graceful length on the palate.

2012 King Estate Pinot Noir, *Oregon* **46.00**

A silky, seductive style with black cherry and raspberry aromas, and flavors of cherry, vanilla, and spice. From Oregon’s most talked about new winery.

Domestic Red Wines

2013 Meomi Pinot Noir, *Santa Barbara County* **38.00**

Velvety and full bodied from the people at Caymus. Its rich dark fruit and integrated oak makes it the perfect Pinot Noir to accompany a steak.

2012 Patz & Hall Pinot Noir, *Sonoma* **70.00**

Bright, fresh cherry and strawberry flavors are echoed on the palate, where complex layers of mulled cherries, strawberries and raspberries intermingle with spicy cinnamon and clove elements.

2010 Saintsbury Pinot Noir, *Carneros* **75.00**

This Pinot Noir displays aromas of spicy red and black fruit seasoned by ageing in Burgundy-made barrels. It has a plump middle, fine-grained tannin and enough acidity to pair with food and to help it age.

2011 Deadly Zins, *California* **32.00**

Aged completely in American oak, it is loaded with berry fruit, pepper spice and earth.

2012 Seghesio Zinfandel, *Sonoma* **45.00**

Lush black raspberry flavors, supple mouth-filling quality with Zinfandel's signature spiciness.

French White Wines

2010 Chateau De Chantegrive, *Graves* **42.00**

This wine is fresh and aromatic with ripe, mineral and fruit and a complex dry finish.
A blend of 50 percent Semillon and 50% Sauvignon Blanc

2010 Joesph Drouhin Pouilly Fuisse, *Bourgogne* **49.00**

This delicious Chardonnay has a brilliant emerald-golden hue. The bouquet is seductive: Floral, and fruity with a dominance of ripe fruit and fresh almonds.

2011 Louis Latour Puligny- Montrachet, *Burgundy* **90.00**

As one of the great expressions of Chardonnay, this wine shows lively citrus and mineral aromas and flavors, with apple and floral notes. The finish is lengthy and creamy.

2011 Domaine du Pre Semele Sancerre, *Loire Valley* **45.00**

Light gold, with aromas of stone fruit, pineapple, and minerals. Flavors are tart and crisp, favoring stone fruit. It is delightfully light and dry.

2010 Bellevue Blanc, *Bordeaux, France* **30.00**

This wine is complex and pleasant with notes of yellow fruits, peaches, and mangoes. Crisp with exotic nuances which ends with a pleasant freshness

French Red Wines

2011 Chateau Bonnet, *Bordeaux* **40.00**

A wonderful blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, and Merlot gives this Bordeaux soft ripe fruit flavors with an attractive cassis element.

2006 Chateau Haut Veyrac, *Saint-Emillion Grand Cru* **55.00**

Classic Bordeaux expression of merlot. Dark fruit and leather aromas followed by rich currant fruit and chocolate.. Old vines average forty years and fourteen months in oak.

2009 Chateau De Malleret, *Haut Medoc, Bordeaux* **50.00**

Blend of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Petit Verdot, this wine has a lush silky texture with beautifully complex fruits of blackberry, cherry and hints of oriental spices and chocolate.

2010 Chateau St. Georges, *St. Emillion, Bordeaux* **60.00**

This full bodied calret is produced from the classic Bordeaux grape varieties, Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc

2011 La Bernadine Rouge Chateauneuf-Du Pape **90.00**

Aromas of currant, plum, coffee, cinnamon, cherry and spice, peppery flavors with nuances of sage, rosemary and red fruit. Rated 93 points Robert Parker.

2010 La Reserve D'Angludet, *Margaux* **60.00**

Deeply colored with a richly layered bouquet that marries blackcurrant and blackberry fruit with the toasty vanilla notes of the oak barrels. The dense, warming palate is refined throughout, with an elegant, tannic structure and perfect acidity.

Italian Wines

2009 Antinori Chianti Riserva, *Tuscany* **60.00**

Antinori makes a seriously good riserva with aromas of prune, leather, and spice that turn to flowers.

2007 La Fiorita, *Brunello di Montalcino* **100.00**

This wine has an intense purple-red color; it expresses fresh plum and berry fruit aromas that gradually give way to a balsamic sense.

2008 Fontanafredda, Serralunga D'Alba, Barolo, *Piedmonte*

Ruby-red color with garnet reflections. The aromas are sharp and intense, with hints of vanilla, spices, withered roses and underbrush. The taste is dry, but soft, full, velvety, harmonious and very long lasting. **78.00**

2008 Ceretto Barolo Zonchera, *Piedmonte* **75.00**

Solidly built and full of personality. Firm and spicy, focused beam of anise and black cherries, followed by a medium tannic finish.

2010 Frescobaldi Nipozanno Chianti Rufina Riserva **50.00**

Offers plummy fruit, with hints of flowers, citrus, and light chocolate. Medium-bodied, with a balanced and tasty palate, fine tannins, and a clean finish.

2013 Barone Fini Valdadige Pinot Grigio **26.00**

A crisp, dry wine from northern Italy, it is fresh and fruity with a flowery bouquet. A perfect accompaniment to light dishes or by itself, as an excellent aperitif.

2011 Santa Margarita Pinot Grigio, *Alto Adige* **46.00**

Dry, fruity, complex and well balanced white wine that has a refreshing and refined finish.

Spanish Wines

2010 Gascon Malbec Reserve, *Mendoza Argentina* **40.00**

This full –bodied wine, intensely flavorful wine has soft round tannins with layers of ripe plum, blackberry and dark cherry, accented by hints of brown spice and chocolate

2010 Martin Codax Albarina, *Spain* **30.00**

This wine’s aroma is reminiscent of fresh herbs and ripe apple. A fine sparkling sensation on the palate with a complexity of tastes denoting the freshness of vegetation in the valley and the essence of the variety

Australian Wines

2012 Layer Cake Shiraz, *Barossa Valley, South Australia* **32.00**

The inaugural release of this new wine from Jayson Woodbridge, the famed cult California producer of Hundred Acre. This wine has a seductive richness. There is an explosion of dark black cherry with exotic spices and chocolate and mocha flavors with a touch of oak.

2010 Penfolds Koonunga Hill Shiraz-Cabernet, *Australia* **25.00**

Estate bottled from one of South Eastern Australia’s Premiere Winery, ripe, silky and plush, with cascades of black-cherry, and raspberry that swirl through the generous finish.

A Wine Spectator Best Buy with “88” points.

2010 Rosemount Shiraz, *Australia* **26.00**

Ripe and juicy, a supple mouthful of berry and cherry fruit shaded with

pretty vanilla and spice notes. Everything lasts impressively on the round finish.

Dessert Wines

2007 Dolce Late Harvest Wine, *Napa* **1/2 Bottle** **95.00**

The only winery in North America dedicated to producing late harvest wine solely. Ripe hay, vanilla and apricot mark the nose; deep orange flavors with cinnamon spice notes and a very smooth mouth feel are just some of the attributing qualities.

Dow's 10 Year Old Tawny Porto, *Portugal* **8.95**

Old and new, with a sweet and sour nose with nuts and fruit. Full-bodies with ripe fruit, this port has a candied fruit and toffee character on the finish.

Graham's Six Grapes, Reserve non-Vintage Port, *Portugal* **6.50**

Blended from two or three years harvests, the Six Grapes blend is a pleasantly rich and fruity style, very nicely balanced and truly special.

Lustau East Indian Shore Sherry, *Spain* **5.95**

One of the rare Sherries that age beautifully in bottle, East India Solera becomes rich, unctuous and remarkably smooth with wonderful flavors reminiscent of ripe figs and raisins.

2003 Taylor Fladgate Port Late Bottle Vintage, *Portugal* **6.50**

From this classic 2004 vintage comes a great value Port. Concentrated ripe fruit flavors and aromas of cherry, crushed berries, plums and minerals.

Yalumba Muscat Show Reserve, *Australia* **1/2 Bottle** **35.00**

Amazingly rich, ripe and powerful, with layers of spice, coffee and molasses around a core of prune and apricot notes. A great dessert wine with a finish

Sparkling Wine and Champagne

France

Bollinger NV Brut Special Cuvee, *France* **100.00**

Created in 1911, the Special Cuvee is the purest expression of the Bollinger Style; of its craftsmanship and singular conception of what Champagne should be.

2004 Dom Perignon, *France* **225.00**

A cuvee of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir made in the famous Methode Champenoise, style to create the pinnacle of all Champagne

G.H. Mumm NV Brut Cordon Rouge, *France* **75.00**

Long aging provides flavors of vanilla, roasted nuts and a hint of toast to the blending of this Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier. The red stripe on the label is recognized around the world as a symbol of one of the best France has to offer.

Moet & Chandon White Star, *France* **78.00**

Made by the producers of Dom Perignon, this extra dry Champagne is fruity and will be enjoyable to all.

Veuve Cliquot Brut Yellow Label, *France* **85.00**

This rich, full-bodied Champagne of ripe fruit and toasty flavors is France's favorite Champagne. Extremely complex and long lasting on the finish.

Sparkling Wine and Champagne

Spain

Freixenet Cordon Negro Brut, *Spain* 24.95

This sparkling wine is dry and crisp, clean and refreshing.

Split 6.95

Marques de Gelida Brut-Cava, *Spain* 29.00

A terrific value in sparkling wine, this blend of four grapes is crisp and dry with notes of honeysuckle and a bright citrusy finish.

Zonin Prosecco, *Italy* split 6.95

Aromatic and crisp, bringing to mind yellow apple, and pear

Mumm Napa Blanc de Noirs, *California* 38.00

Please do not be deceived by the delicate salmon pink color of this wine. It starts with a delicious cherry aroma from the predominance of Pinot Noir in the blend, but the addition of Chardonnay gives it structure and great depth of flavor. It can take on the spicy or hot dishes, or heartier fare that a more shy and retiring sparkler might be lost with. This is a nice choice for either surf or turf – or both!

Roederer Estate NV Brut, *Anderson Valley* 40.00

The first California sparkling wine produced by Champagne Louis Roederer builds upon a 200 year wine-making tradition. This is one of California's premier producers, made from only estate grown grapes, a portion of which have been aged in French oak and added to the blend, creating a multi-vintage cuvee with body, finesse and depth of style.

Schramsberg Blanc de Blancs, *North Coast, California* **½ Bottle** **29.95**

Fresh aromas of green apple, juicy pineapple and ripe grapefruit, accented by a slight minerality on the finish.
